The University of Arkansas Libraries serve as a portal to GIS resources in partnership with the Center for Advanced Spatial Technologies (CAST). In a Web-based program, students and faculty access geospatial and attribute data, including two resources developed on campus: Arkansas' "GeoStor" and the Web-guide "Starting the Hunt." The Libraries' GIS Web page also introduces GIS software available through ESRI's Academic Site License, GIS training opportunities, and GIS activities on campus. This new GIS program is designed as a model of collaboration among libraries, research centers, computing services, and academic departments promoting GIS opportunities in higher education.
