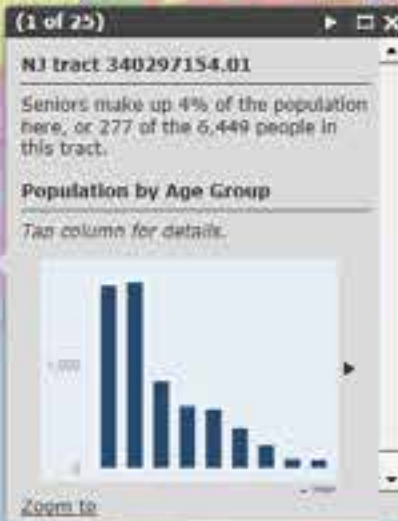

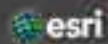

Comparing unemployment and population change reveals regional patterns

Despite recent signs of recovery, unemployment remains a major national issue. How do patterns of unemployment relate to regional changes in population?



UNEMPLOYMENT POPULATION CHANGE RELATIONSHIP

Relationship of unemployment to population change

The analysis shows that in some parts of the country, population and unemployment tend to parallel each other (blue).

- **The Great Plains:** Declining population and low unemployment.
- **Coastal California:** Increasing populations and high unemployment.

...while in others, they tend to run in opposition (red).

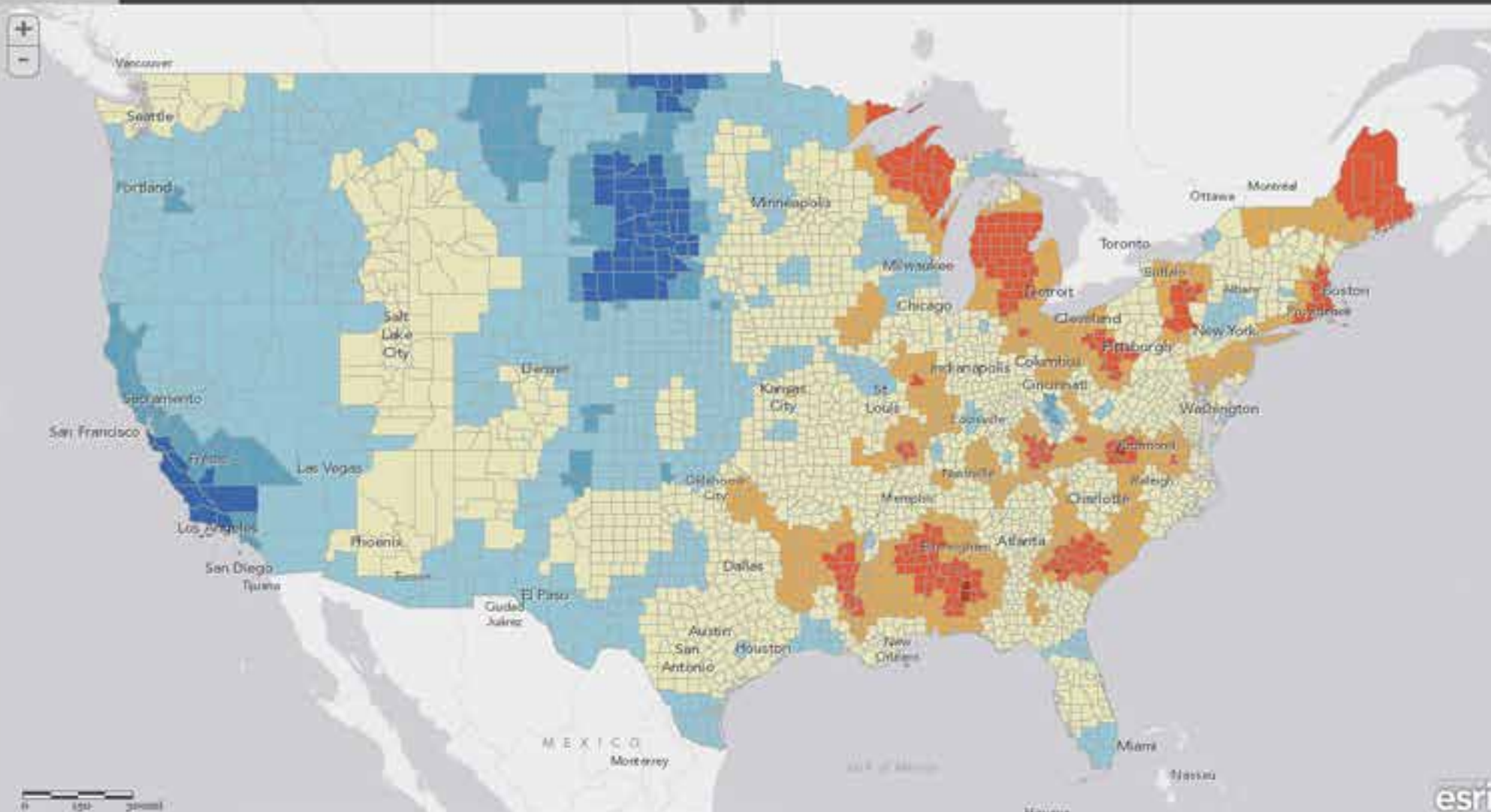
- **Deep South, Rust Belt, and Upper Midwest:** Static or decreasing populations and high unemployment.

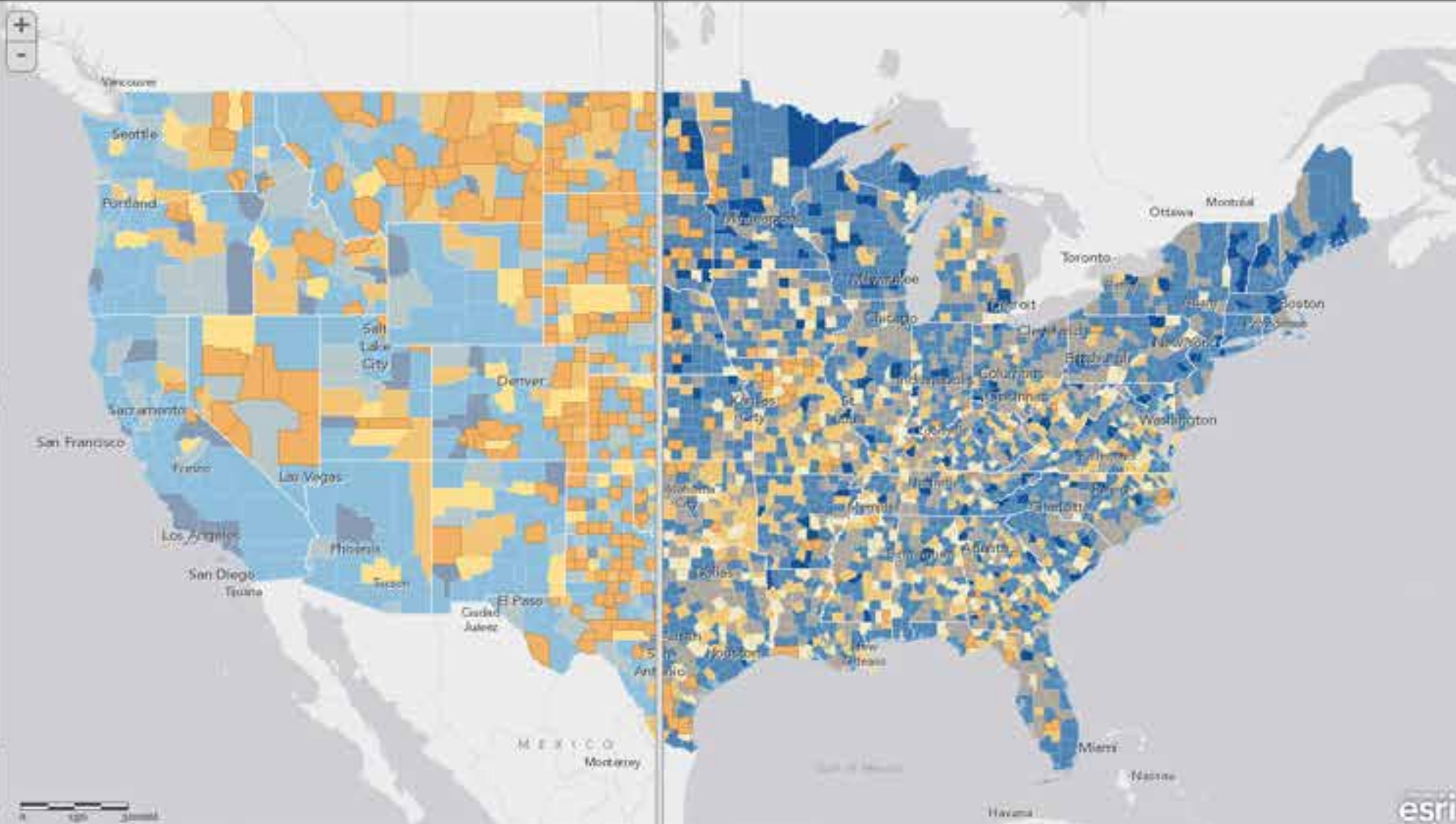
The availability of basic health care varies radically from place to place across the nation.

To the left of the vertical slider bar, counties outlined in orange had no doctor's office in 2009, according to the Census Bureau. Clark County, Mississippi, for example, had a population of over 17,000 but no doctor's office, while Manhattan had a doctor's office for every 500 residents.

The map to the right shows the relative availability of primary health care providers by county. Enhanced access to health care is key to improving the health of Americans.

Doctor's office data is from the U.S. Census Bureau's County Business Patterns and Population Estimates programs.

Primary care provider data is from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' leading health indicators.

AGE BY SEX

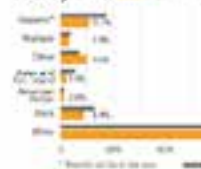

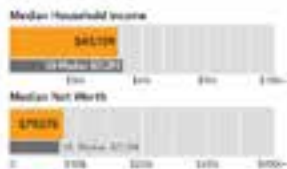

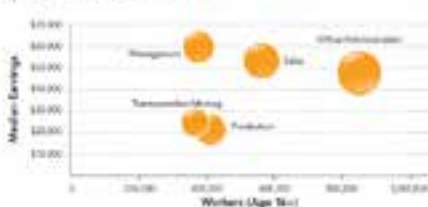
