





Health and Wellness Alliance for Children (HWAC)



Coalition of more than **40** community organizations established to improve the health and well being of children in Dallas County.

Uses a "collective impact" approach, encourages collaboration across sectors including health, education, government, nonprofits and the faith community.

The Health and Wellness Alliance's initial focus is pediatric asthma.

- ❖ ~60,000 children in Dallas have asthma
- Annual economic cost to Dallas is estimated to be a staggering \$60M

Metrics: Hospitalizations/ED visits from Asthma








GIS Portrait:

- We wanted to know where everything was Spatially in terms of our Pediatric Population, Location of Hospitals, 18 Pediatric Group Clinics, 26 Telemedicine sites FQHC's, COPC, Providers and everything that relates to everyday needs for a healthy population
- Geographic Landscape is the same for everyone




 Started using GIS in May 2014 (trial version); Purchased our first ArcGIS License in June 2014









WHERE are we in DFW – Location, Location, Location?






Childrens Health Pediatric Group Patient Encounters Study: WHERE and WHO we Serve




Mission East Dallas Asthma Study: Is there a cluster?



CHST Patient Taxi Services & Dallas Council Districts Study: WHO are our Elected Officials




2012 Asthma ED Rate and % Poverty in Dallas County Study


