New Madrid Seismic Zone when a 7.7 magnitude hits

- Home to 50 million people
- Major river transportation
- 86,000 casualties
- 7.2 million displaced
- Direct economic losses of \$300 billion
- Indirect economic losses of \$600 billion +



New Madrid Seismic Zone when a 7.7 magnitude hits

- Disruptions to supply chains
- Damage to oil & gas pipelines interrupt nationwide service
- 3,500 bridges damaged
- 715,000 buildings damages
- 2.6 million households without power
- 130 hospitals damaged

Why Share Information? How Hard Can it Be?


- Our partners have their own systems



18 Essential Elements of Information (EEIs)

Benefits of Using EEIs

- Covers most response partners' basic data needs
- Establishes a "starting point" in data sharing between agencies/organizations
- When applied properly, establishes an "end point" for data sharing
- Broader audience understands the meaning behind the map
- Data owners maintain control (access/QC) of their information






ArcGIS rest service end point created with data from WebEOC fusion board






Operations dashboard - numbers behind the pictures



Identification of Mission Ready Packages






Local EM Staffing in Kentucky




