Imagery @ UC-Keynote and User Perspectives

Goals of the workshop

The purpose of this session is to provide a keynote presentation on imagery as the first of a number of Imagery @ UC activities being held Tuesday through Wednesday. Additionally, an overview of the Imagery @ UC activities will be presented to enable attendees to understand all of the imagery related activities at the Esri User Conference.

Major topics covered

The keynote presentation will be given by Dr. Einar Bjorgo from the United Nations Operational Satellite Applications Programme (UNOSAT). He will describe how UNOSAT are using imagery and GIS to impact decisions and make a difference in the humanitarian and security domains, as well as giving his perspective on potential future uses of imagery and GIS.
