

# **Bullets in the Projects: New York City Public Housing as Gun Violence Hot Spots**

## New York City Public Housing Authority (NYCHA)

- Created in 1934
- Largest Public Housing Authority in the U.S.
- 31<sup>st</sup> Most Populated City in the U.S.
- NYCHA has 13,000+ Employees
- Low-Moderate income housing throughout NYC (mean household income in NYCHA is \$23,672)
- Average Rent \$483 / month
- 328 'Projects' / 'Developments'
- 181,581 housing units (apartments)
- NYCHA is 8.1% of the total NYC housing units



## NYCHA Population (2015)

- Total Population: 401,093 (4.7% of NYC Population)
- Total 'Families' : 174,529
- Average Years in NYCHA: 20.5 years
- Total Minors (<18): 109,627
- Total 'Elderly' (>62) 76,964
- Average 26% unemployment

## Unofficial NYCHA (Ghost) Population

- Ghost Population includes 'unofficial residents'
- 200,000+ ghosts living in NYCHA
- Unofficial Population of 600,000+  
(7% of NYC Population)
- Population based on pro-rated estimates using:
  - Utilities (water, electric, gas)
  - Trash
  - School Attendance



# Crime in Public Housing

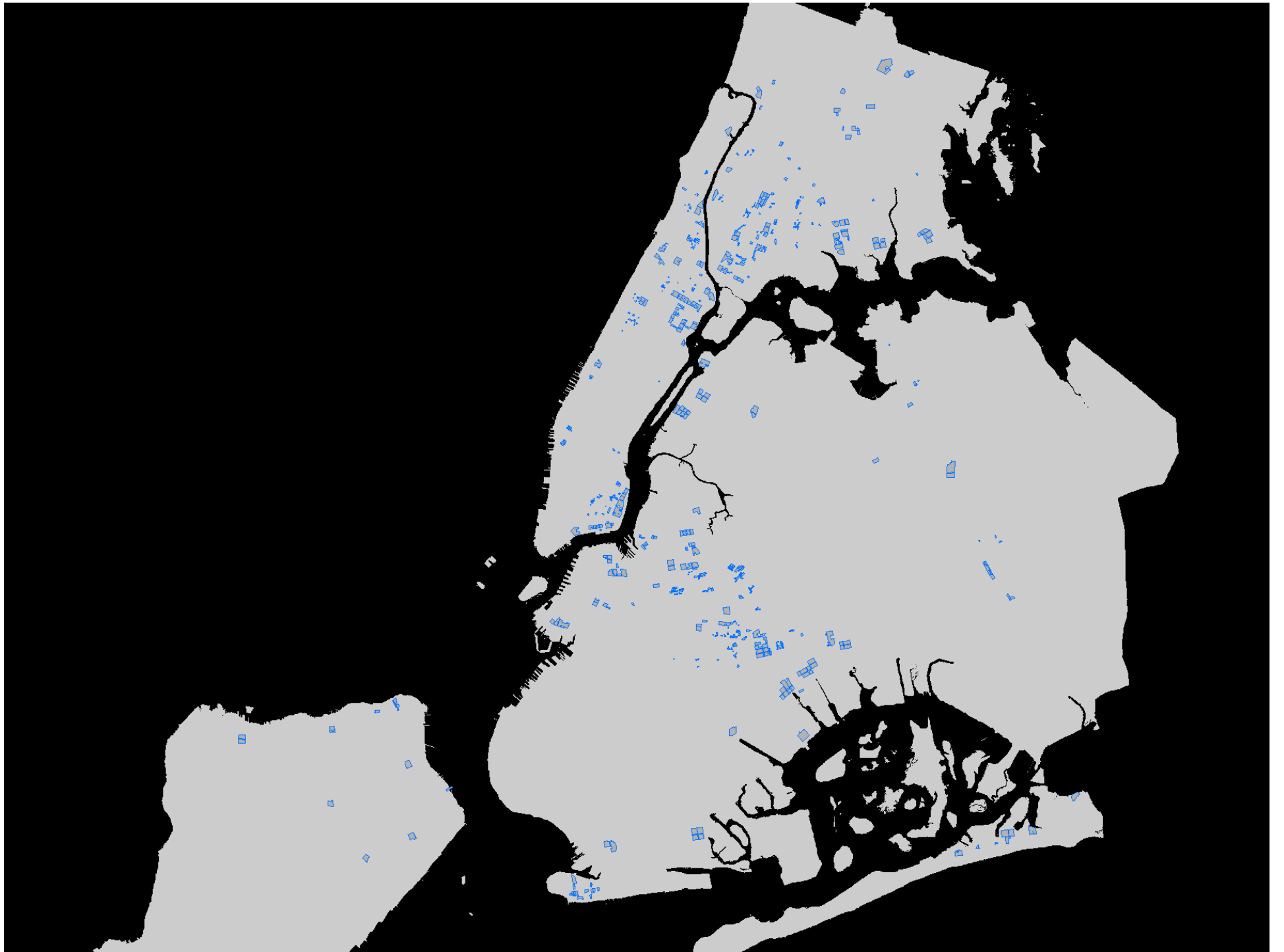
- Overall, trends show crime is going up...
- Some PJ's have significant increases
- More dangerous now, than in the last 10 years...
- 15 Projects (4.6%) make up 20% of violent crime

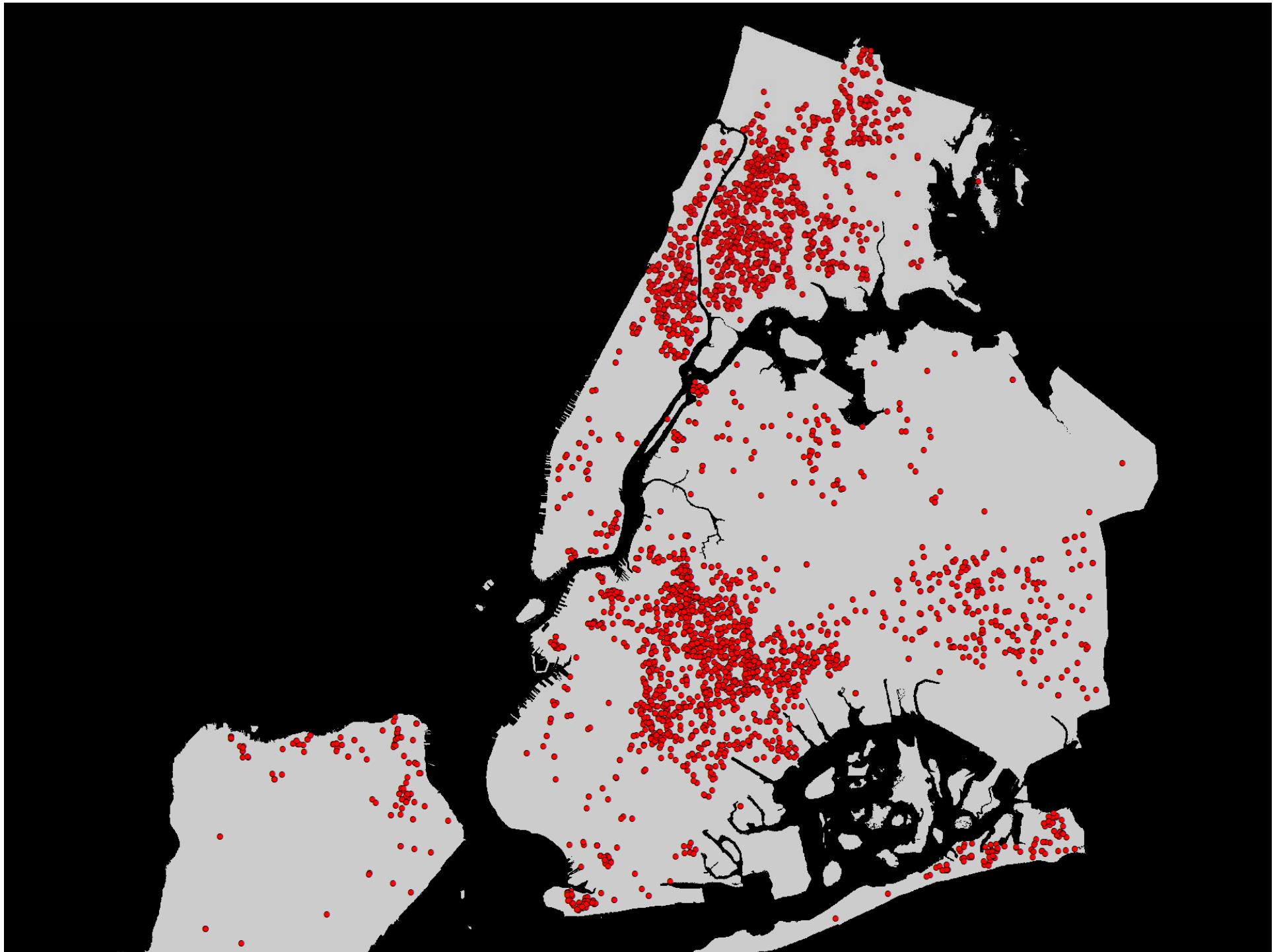
<b>CRIME</b>	<b>3-Year Average</b>	<b>NYCHA (% of NYC)</b>
<b>Murder</b>	<b>53</b>	<b>16%</b>
<b>Shooting (Vics)</b>	<b>253</b>	<b>19%</b>
<b>Rape</b>	<b>148</b>	<b>11%</b>
<b>Robbery</b>	<b>1144</b>	<b>7%</b>
<b>Assault</b>	<b>2142</b>	<b>11%</b>
<b>TOTAL VIOLENT</b>	<b>5173</b>	<b>10%</b>



## Gun Violence in NYCHA – ‘Tale of Two Cities’

- NYC Averages 1345 shooting victims annually
- **NYCHA Averages 253 shooting victims (19%)**
- NYC 5-year trend is -24.2% decrease
- **NYCHA 5-year trend is +8.2 increase**
- NYC Victimization rate 12.8 / 100,000
- **NYCHA Victimization rate 63.3 / 100,000**

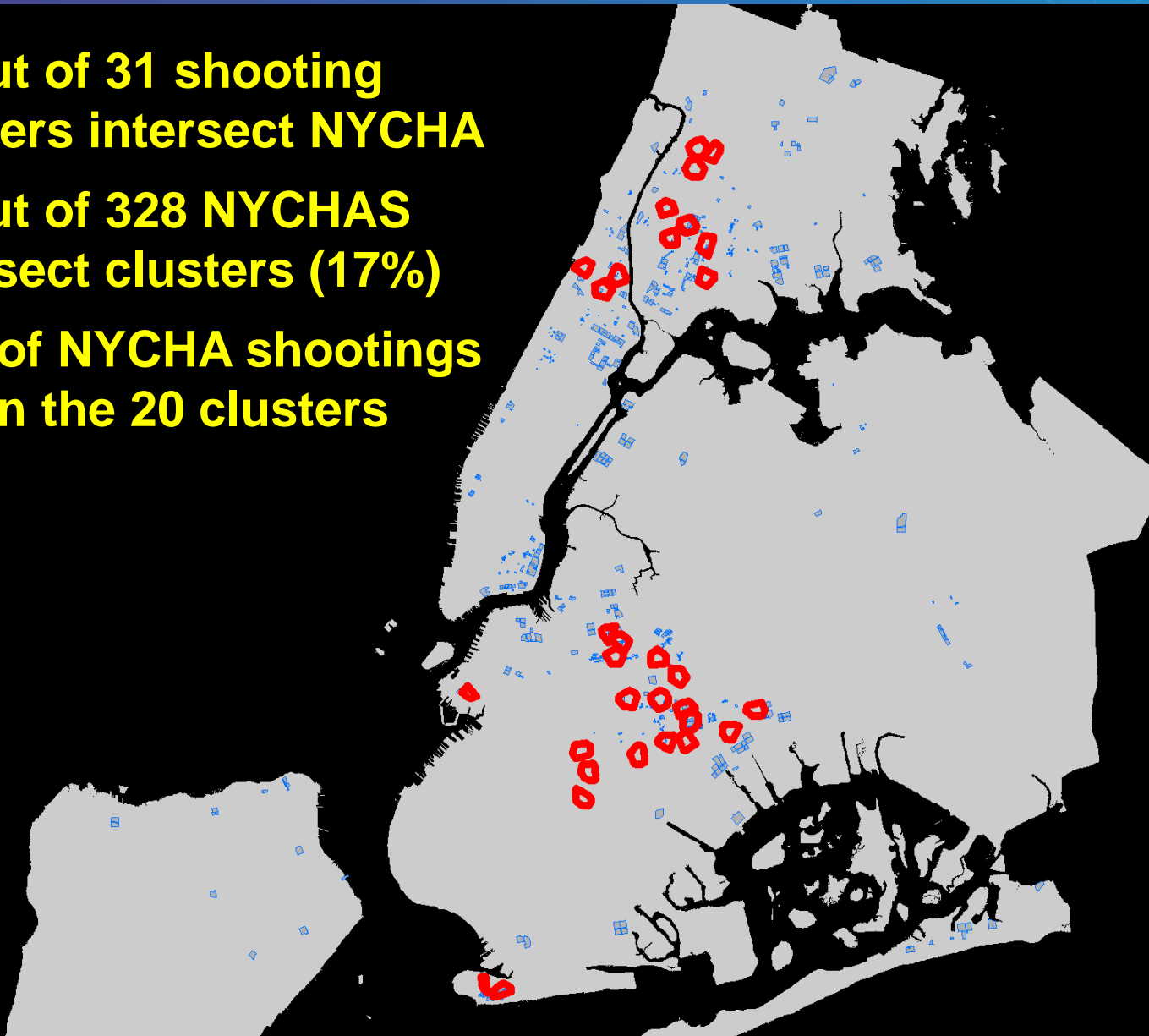




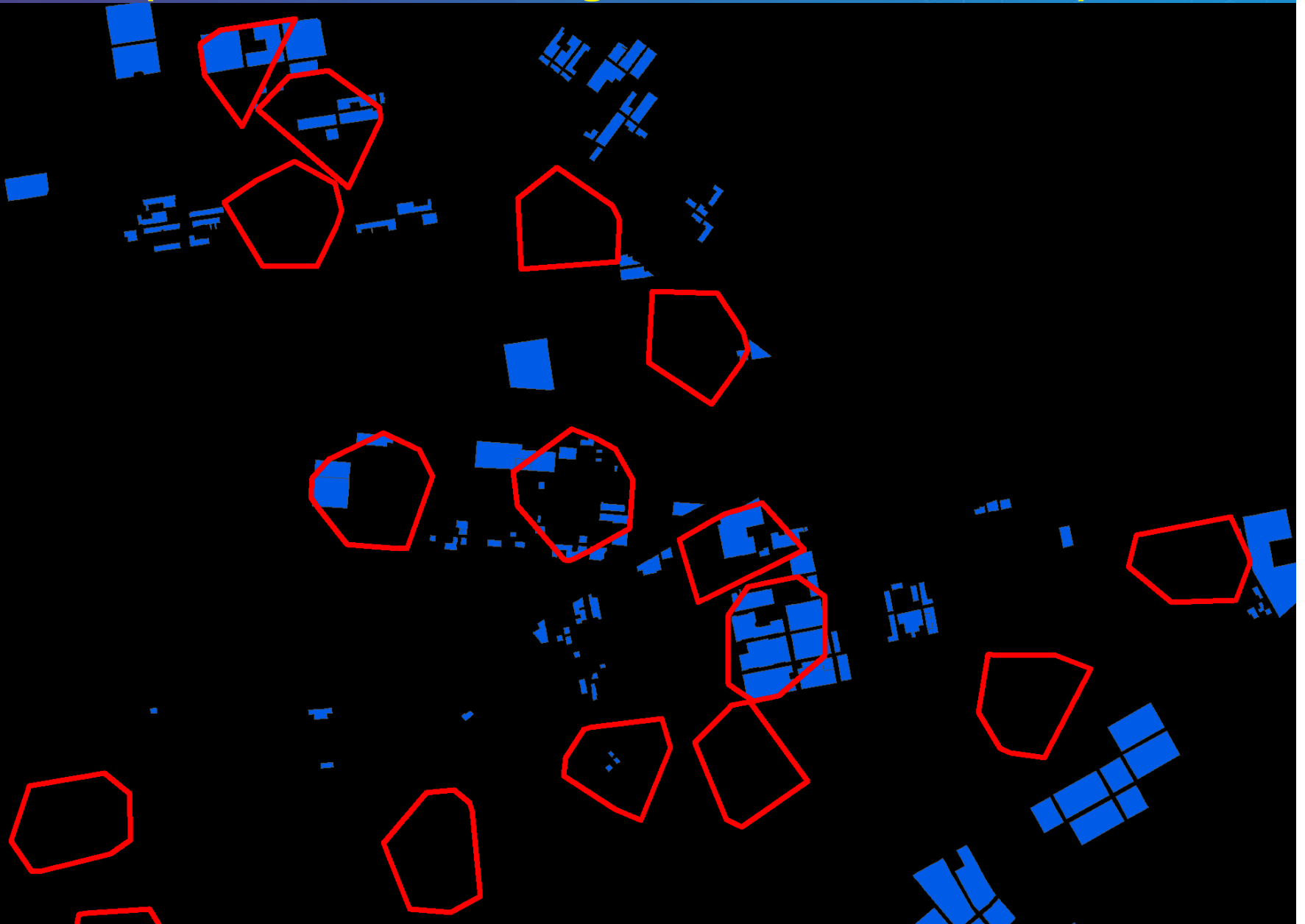


## Nearest Neighbor Hierarchical Cluster Map (30 or more shootings within .25 mile area)

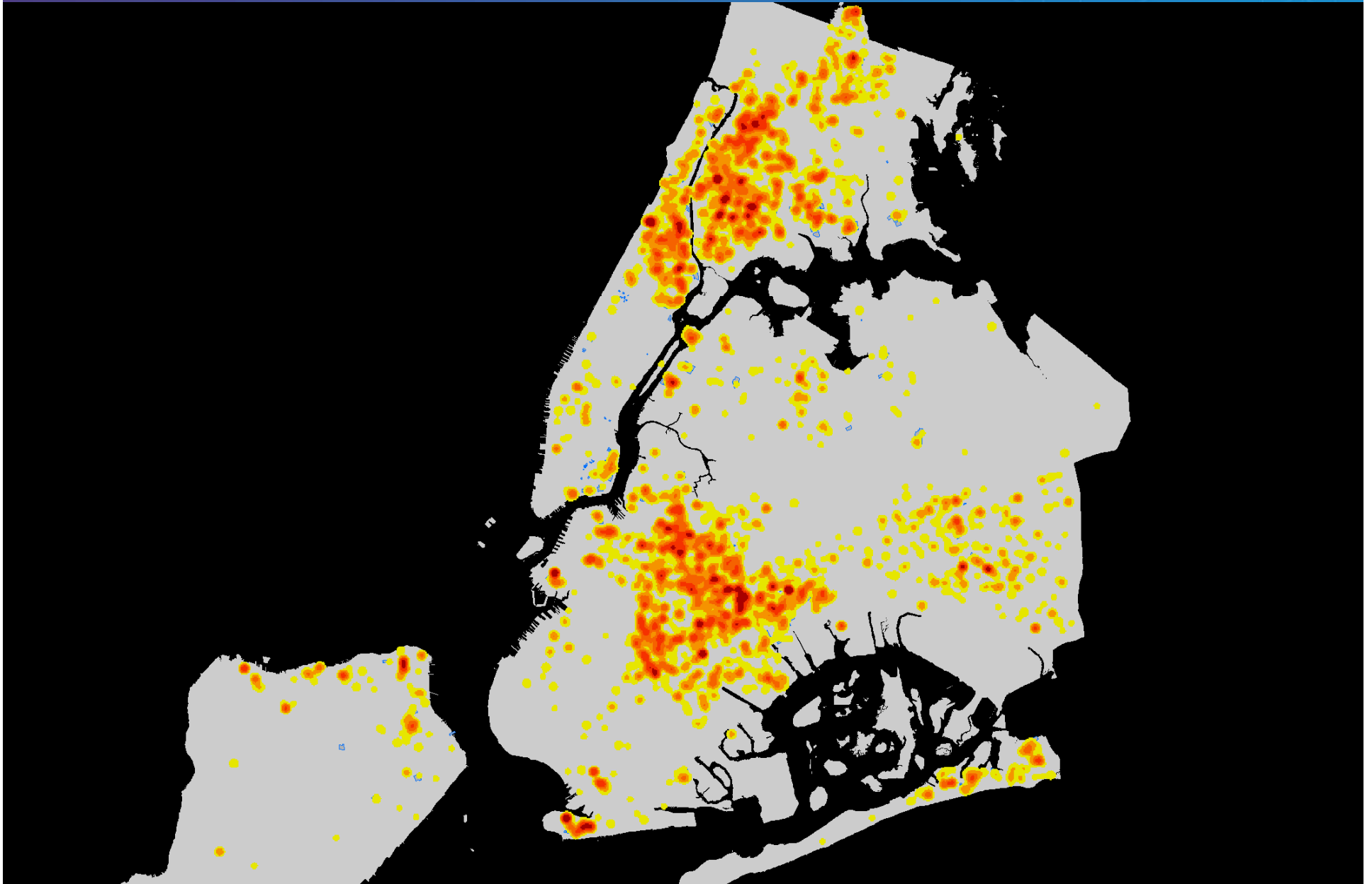
- 20 out of 31 shooting clusters intersect NYCHA
- 56 out of 328 NYCHAS intersect clusters (17%)
- 16% of NYCHA shootings within the 20 clusters



# Nearest Neighbor Hierarchical Cluster Map (30 or more shootings within .25 mile area)

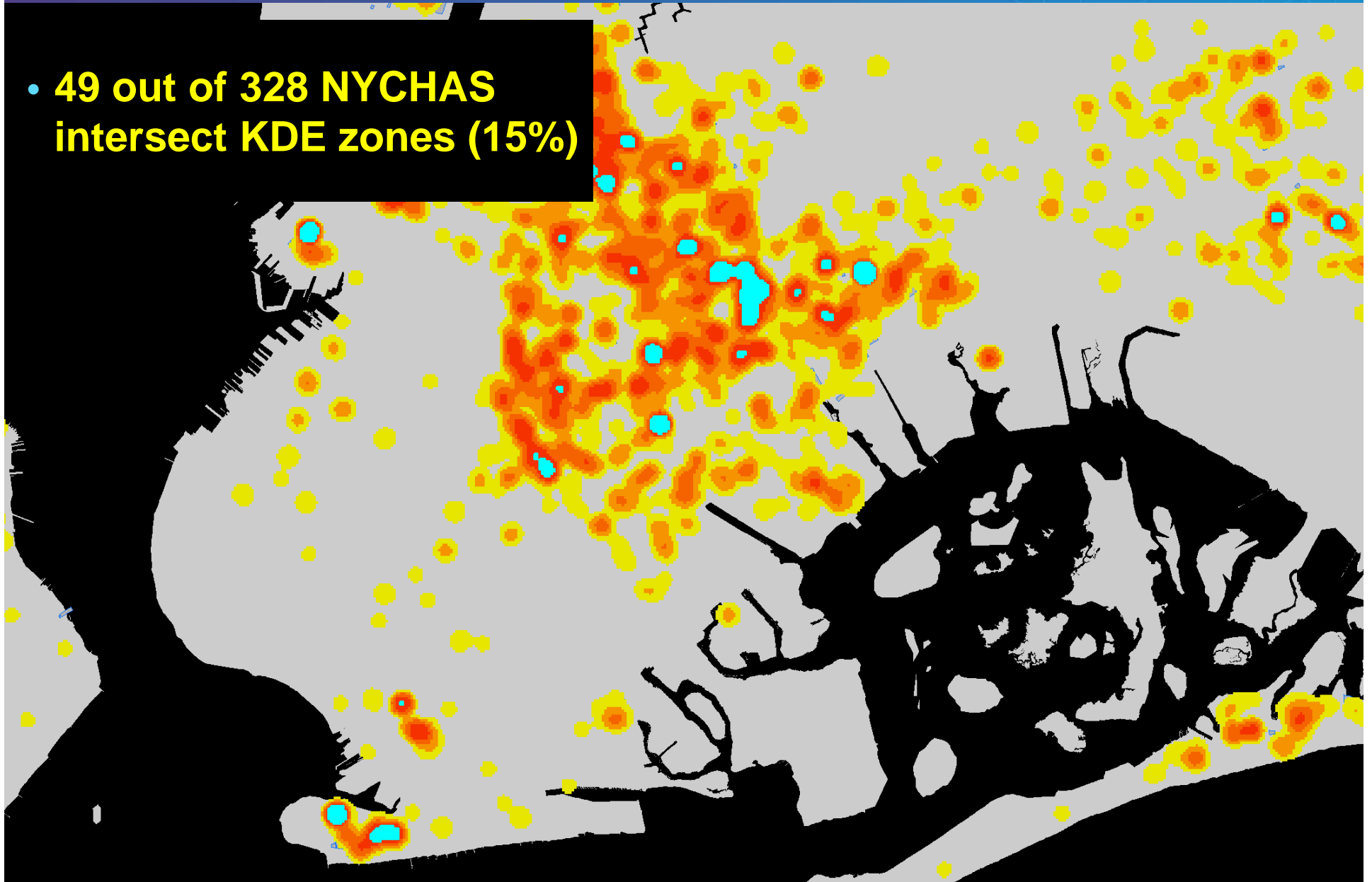


# Single Kernel Density Estimation



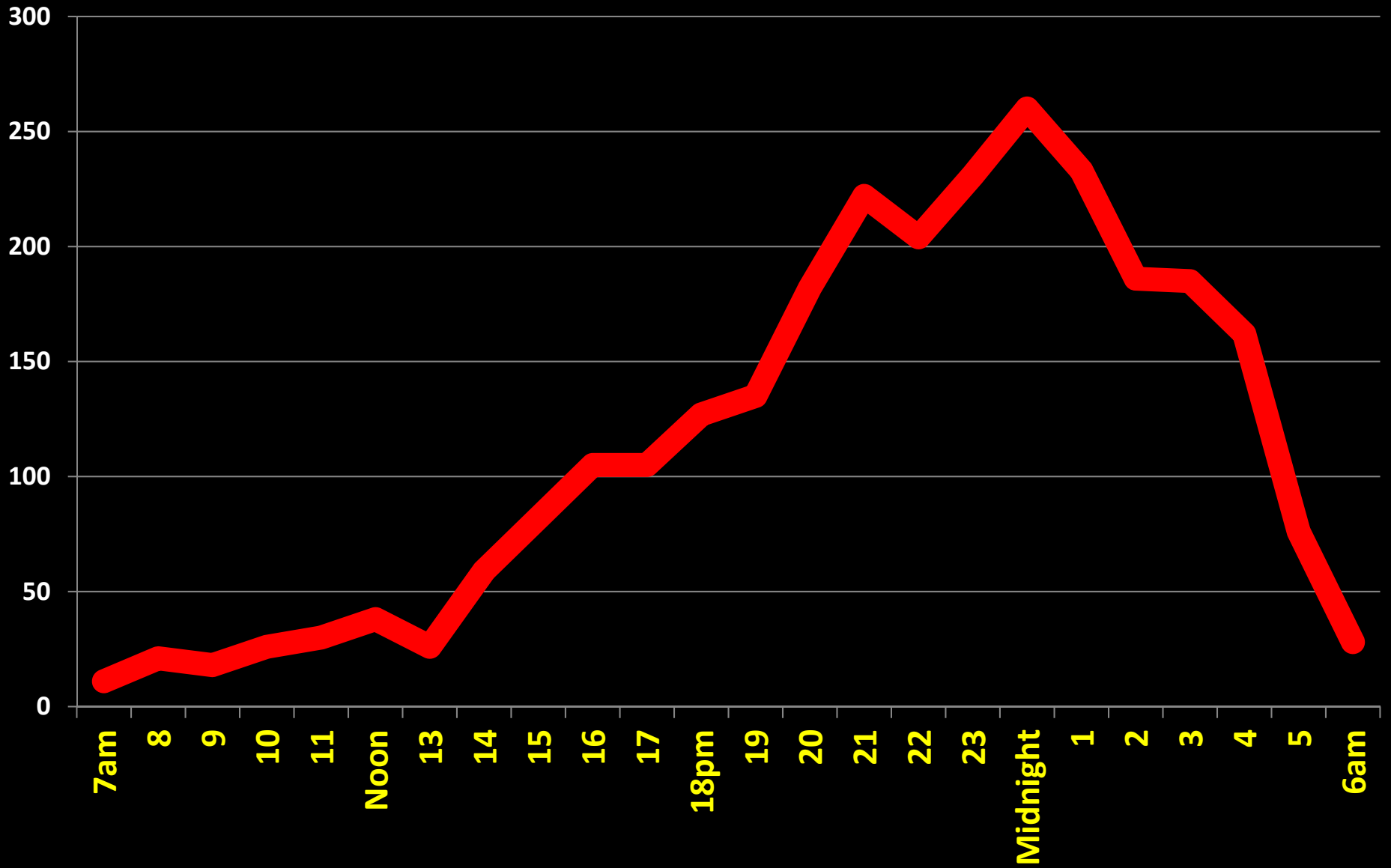
# Raster Calculator, Export, Dissolve, Intersect

- 49 out of 328 NYCHAS intersect KDE zones (15%)

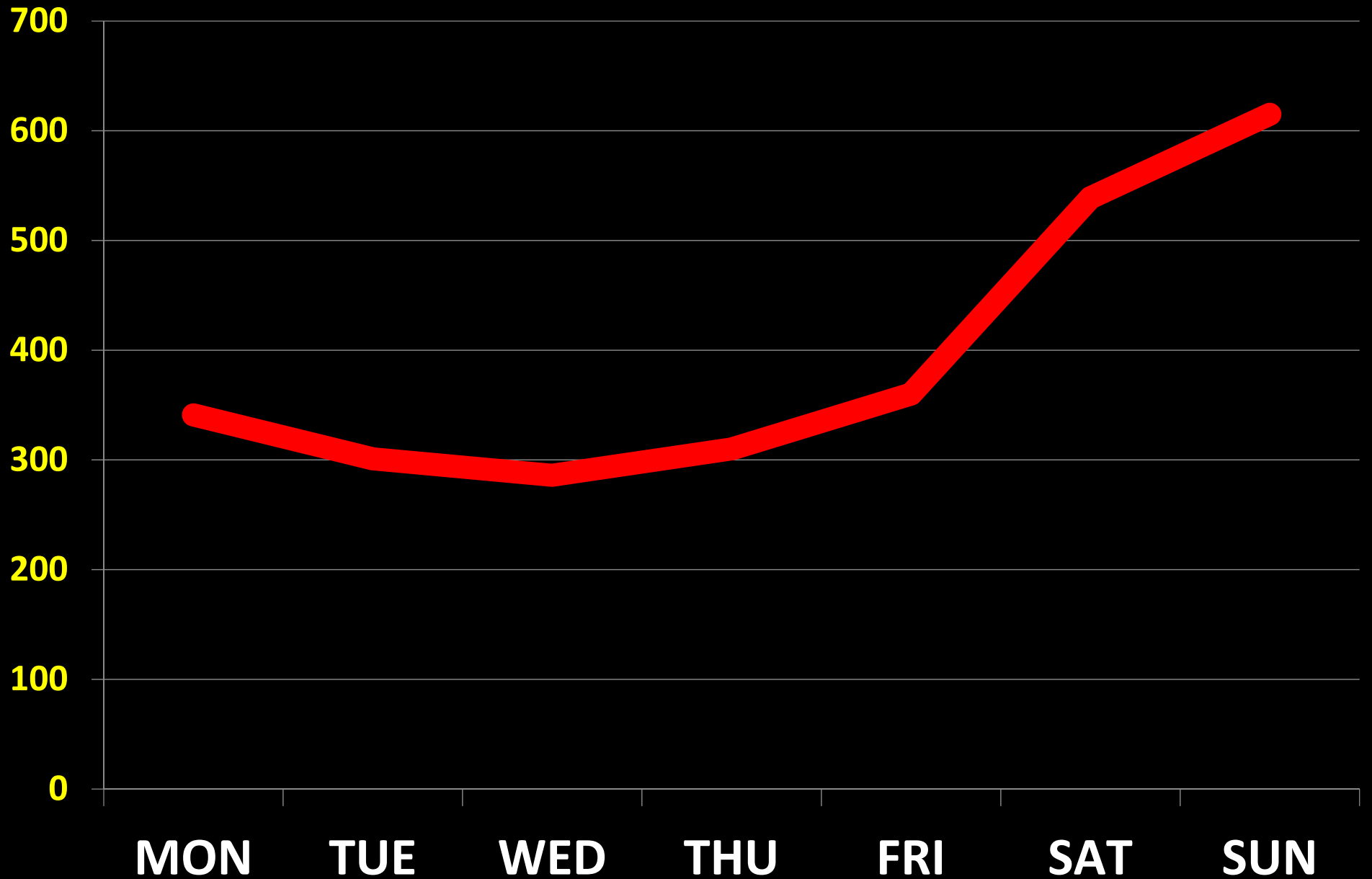




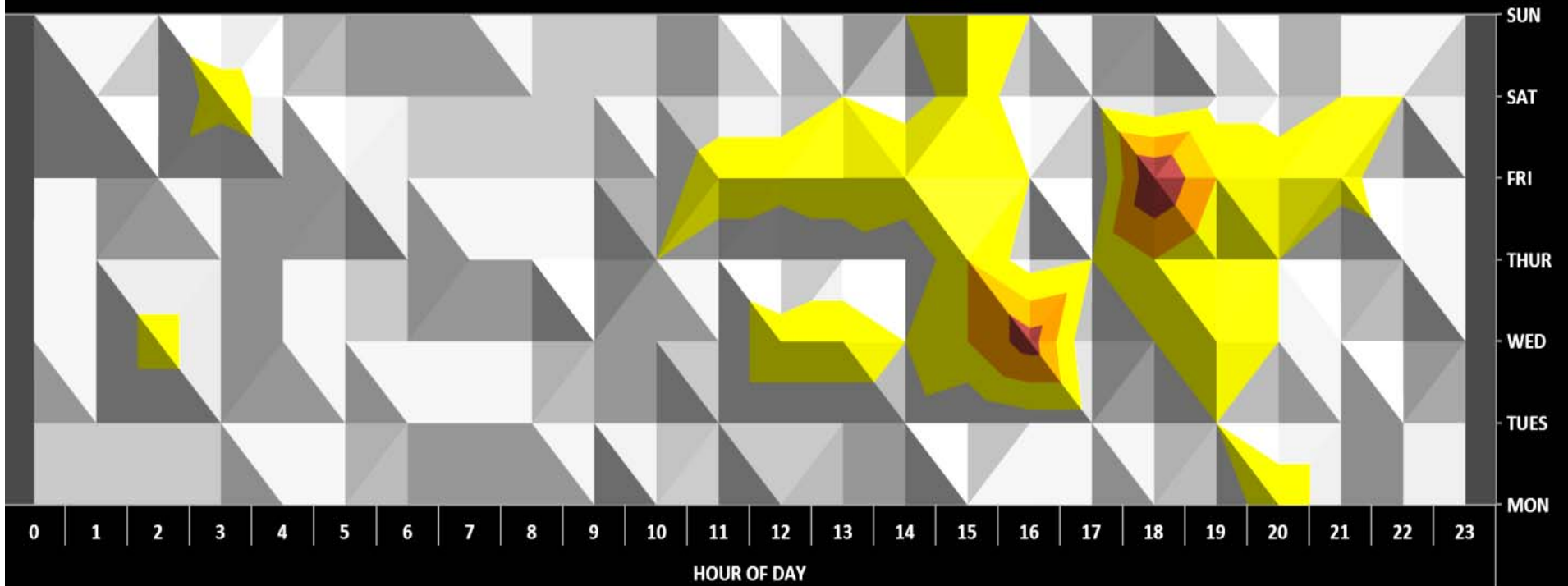
# Shootings - Hour of Day Trends

- **78% of shootings occur between 5:30pm – 7pm on Thursdays and Fridays**



# Public Policy Implications

- In some gentrified neighborhoods in NYC, crime is going down significantly and respective NYCHA crime is going up significantly.
- Space-Time Crime Analysis saves time, money, resources, and is much more effective.
- Improved lighting
- 'Not Wanted List'
- CCTV locations
- Shotspotter locations
- Improved NYPD / NYCHA partnerships

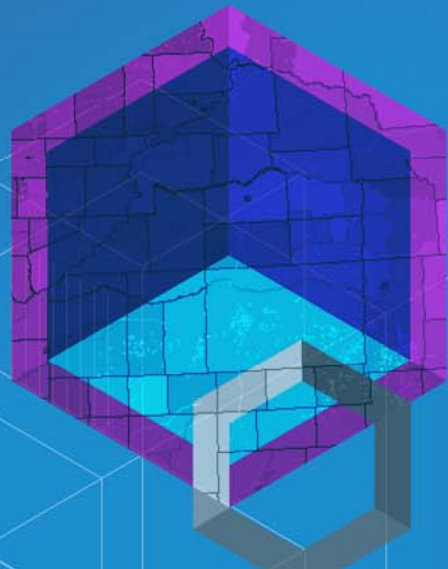
