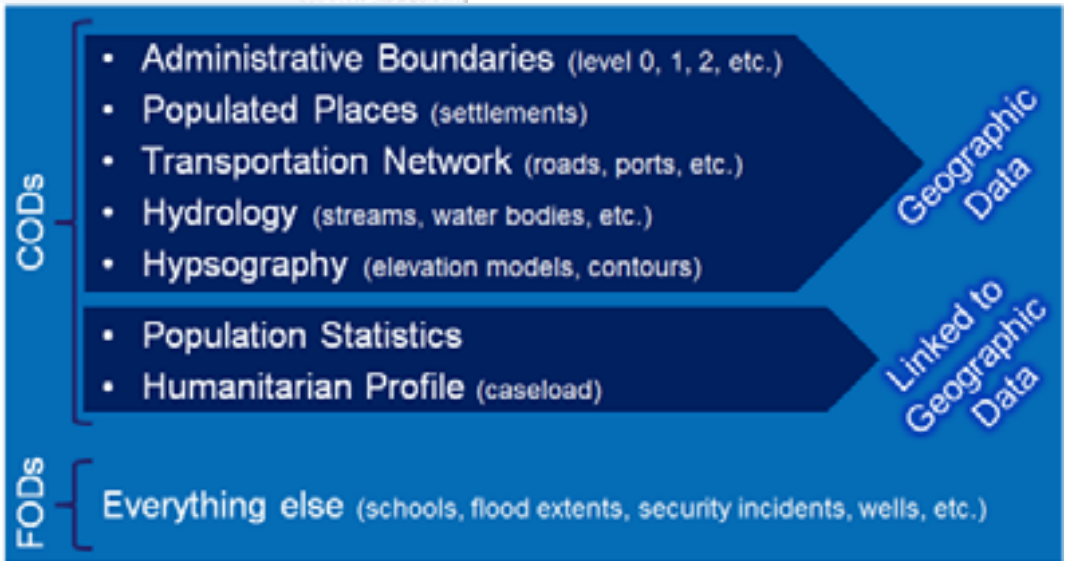

Challenges

- Data availability
- Discrepancies to overcome
- Data sharing
- Cost: financial, time, resources
- Prioritization of preparedness activities

Key Messages
