Scope: On Monday, July 4 th , 2011, Macy's Department Store will host their 35 th Annual Fireworks Spectacular, in the Borough of Manhattan. The display will be performed on the Hudson River and will consist of six barges. The barges will be placed along the Manhattan Shoreline centered off 55 th Street (Barge 6), centered off 48 th Street (Barge 5), centered off 41 st Street (Barge 4), centered off 34 th Street (Barge 3), centered off 27 th Street (Barge 2), centered off 20 th Street (Barge 1). Viewing will be North and South of the barges for watercraft and along 12 th Avenue for spectators.		
General Control Objectives for the Incident (include alternatives): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure the safety of the public and members of the Department • Monitor waterways for life safety and fire protection • Provide fire protection to the event area by dedicating resources to the area. • Provide emergency medical services according to established protocols • Provide Technical and Mass Decon as needed

If a verbal alarm (for life safety) is received, unit shall respond to alarm and notify dispatcher that a similar unit should be dedicated to the event. Dispatcher shall relocate that unit to original unit's assignment.

North Sector will handle all requests for EMS, including 911 calls: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Henry Hudson parkway from West 96th Street to West 79th Street Riverside Boulevard. Perform necessary skills for life and non-life threatening conditions in accordance with protocols. Implement on-scene triage procedures when presented with patients requiring prioritization and rapid identification of multiple patients. Provide transportation of patients to an appropriate emergency care facility. 					
Special Instructions:					
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the event of patient contact, the unit will notify the special street dispatcher of the location, patient condition, transport necessity and final disposition. If a patient requires transport, the unit shall notify the dispatcher where the ambulance shall meet the unit (closest street location, east-west/ east-west). Crews will remove patients from the Henry Hudson Pkwy to ambulances at ground level. Ambulances will not enter the Henry Hudson Pkwy without authorization from their offices. All Patient contact must be tracked by calling EMSD at 347-250-6111.
