## **Using GIS to Help With Electronics Recycling**

The National Electronic Product Stewardship Initiative (NEPSI) has been working to develop a system for the collection, reuse, and recycling of electronics that can be implemented nation-wide. The Seattle-Tacoma Metropolitan Statistical Area was selected as the initial study area for determining the base level of service and associated costs. This paper describes how GIS was used to help evaluate nine different scenarios and how it might be applied in other regions of the country.
