Organize Map Assets with Styles In ArcGIS Pro

Styles to promote consistency and standardization across maps and layouts

- The galleries you see when you author maps and layouts are filled with style items
- Styles store:
 - symbols
 - colors
 - color schemes
 - label placements
 - layout items

Types of styles

In ArcGIS Pro

- Project styles:
 - those referenced by the project
- Favorites style:
 - linked to your profile, not the project, always available, not shared
- System styles:
 - Esri styles included with ArcGIS Pro download. Add to project, not shared, read-only
- Custom styles:
 - any style that is not a system style or your Favorites style, usually writeable
- Solution styles:
 - usually Esri-authored, intended for a specific industry or solution, found on ArcGIS Online
- Mobile styles:
 - paired down style schema that can be used in mobile applications

Styles: Tips and Tricks

In ArcGIS Pro

- Copy symbols from read-only system styles to your own styles
 - modify as necessary
- Add styles directly from the Format Symbol pane gallery
- Import styles from ArcMap directory
- Save colors to Favorites style for consistency
- Share styles via portal
- Convert representations to ArcGIS Pro symbols by saving them to an ArcMap style
