

- Hosted in ArcGIS Online
- Published by both Esri and ArcGIS community




#### Living Atlas content in ArcGIS Enterprise

- Hosted in ArcGIS Online
- Layers, web maps, apps and scenes published by Esri
- Content is updated frequently but item details are updated with each Enterprise release
- Require internet access




Create web maps, apps and share the content



Perform analysis


#### Living Atlas content in ArcGIS Enterprise

- Default content
  - Available by default
  - Consumes at no cost
- Subscriber content
  - Admin enables the content with Online subscription account
  - Consumes at no additional cost
- Premium content
  - Admin enables the content with Online subscription account
  - Consumes a nominal amount of service credits




## Benefits of using such content in ArcGIS Enterprise

- Authoritative ready to use, preconfigured content from Esri
- Content is updated frequently as hosted in ArcGIS Online
- All Enterprise users can access the content once enabled
- Easy to browse or search content in Enterprise portal



## Living Atlas content in ArcGIS Enterprise

 Enable the Subscriber content in your Enterprise portal to unlock almost 70% of content <u>at no</u> <u>additional cost!</u>



#### Enable the content

- No need to enable default content
- Admin enables subscriber or premium content
  - with ArcGIS Online subscription account




#### Disconnected Enterprise deployment

- Admin disables the content
- Afterwards, no Living Atlas content is showing up in Enterprise portal



#### Esri Boundary Layers

- Standard Geographies with attribute of population
- Published as hosted feature layers in your Enterprise portal
- Use in maps, apps, analysis tools and Insights for ArcGIS



#### Release of Esri Boundary Layers

- 10.5 released two boundary layers
  - USA Boundaries 2015
  - World Boundaries 2015
- 10.5.1 released boundary layers for 120+ countries
  - South America
  - North America
  - Europe
  - Asia
  - Africa
  - Australia
  - Oceania

#### Benefits of using Esri Boundary Layers

- Authoritative ready to use, preconfigured content from Esri
- Improve analysis performance for Enterprise users
- Perfect solution for disconnected Enterprise deployment
- Support Insights for ArcGIS



#### Host Esri boundary layers within Enterprise portal

- Boundary layers get downloaded from MyEsri
- Admin publishes layers to Enterprise portal as hosted feature layers
- Hosted boundary layers are accessible to all Enterprise users



#### Key points to take home

- Two types of Living Atlas content is available starting Enterprise 10.5.
- 1) Living Atlas content hosted in ArcGIS Online
  - A majority of content consumes at no additional cost
  - Premium content (~5%) consumes a nominal amount of service credits
  - It's shared with all Enterprise users once enabled
- 2) Esri boundary layers available to be downloaded and hosted within your own ArcGIS
   Enterprise
  - Improve analysis performance
  - Disconnected Enterprise deployment
  - Layers for 120+ countries are released at 10.5.1
- Enabling both content is easy to achieve


