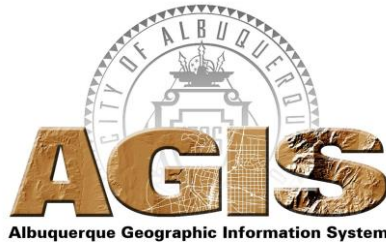

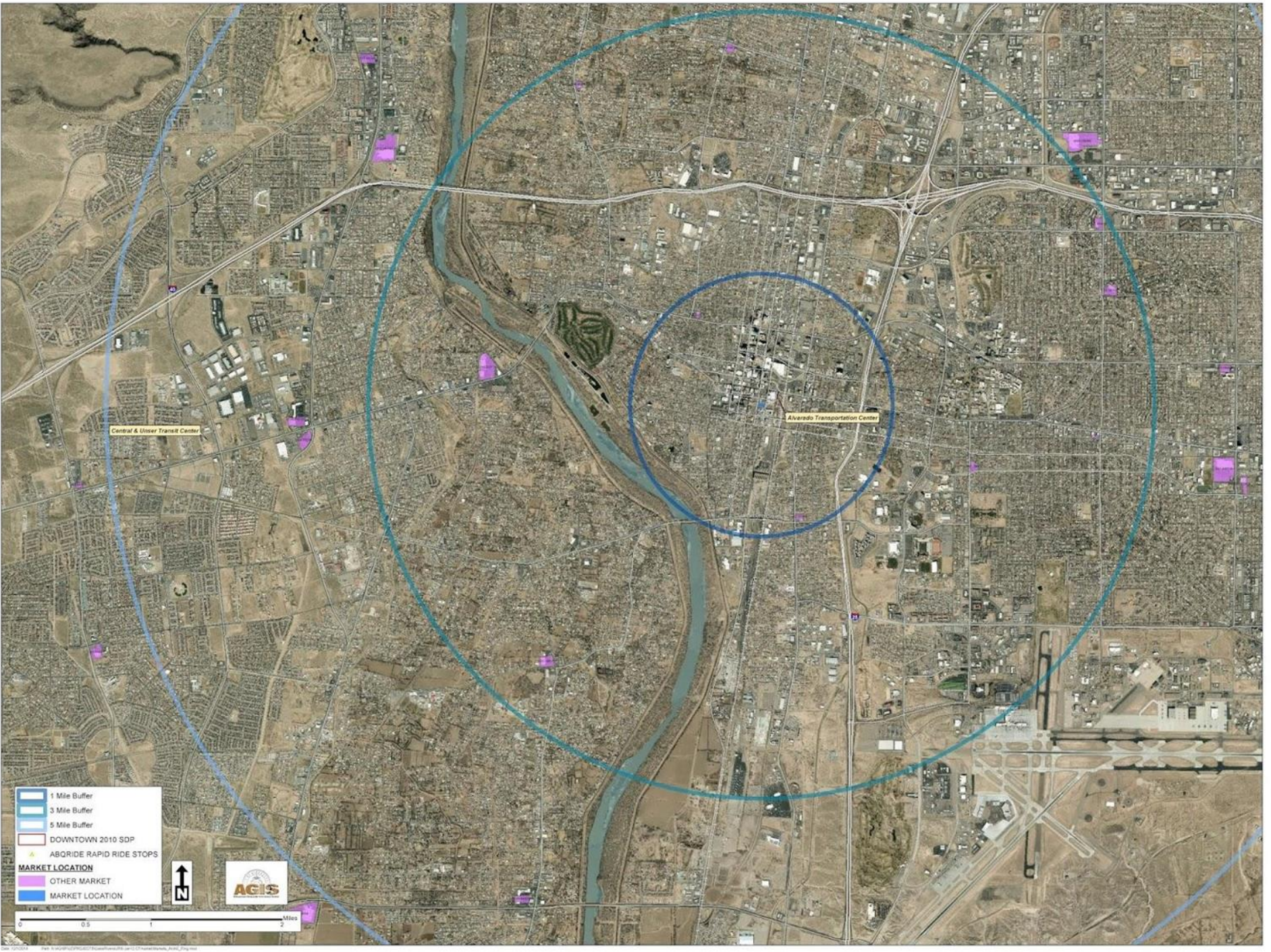

MARKET LOCATION



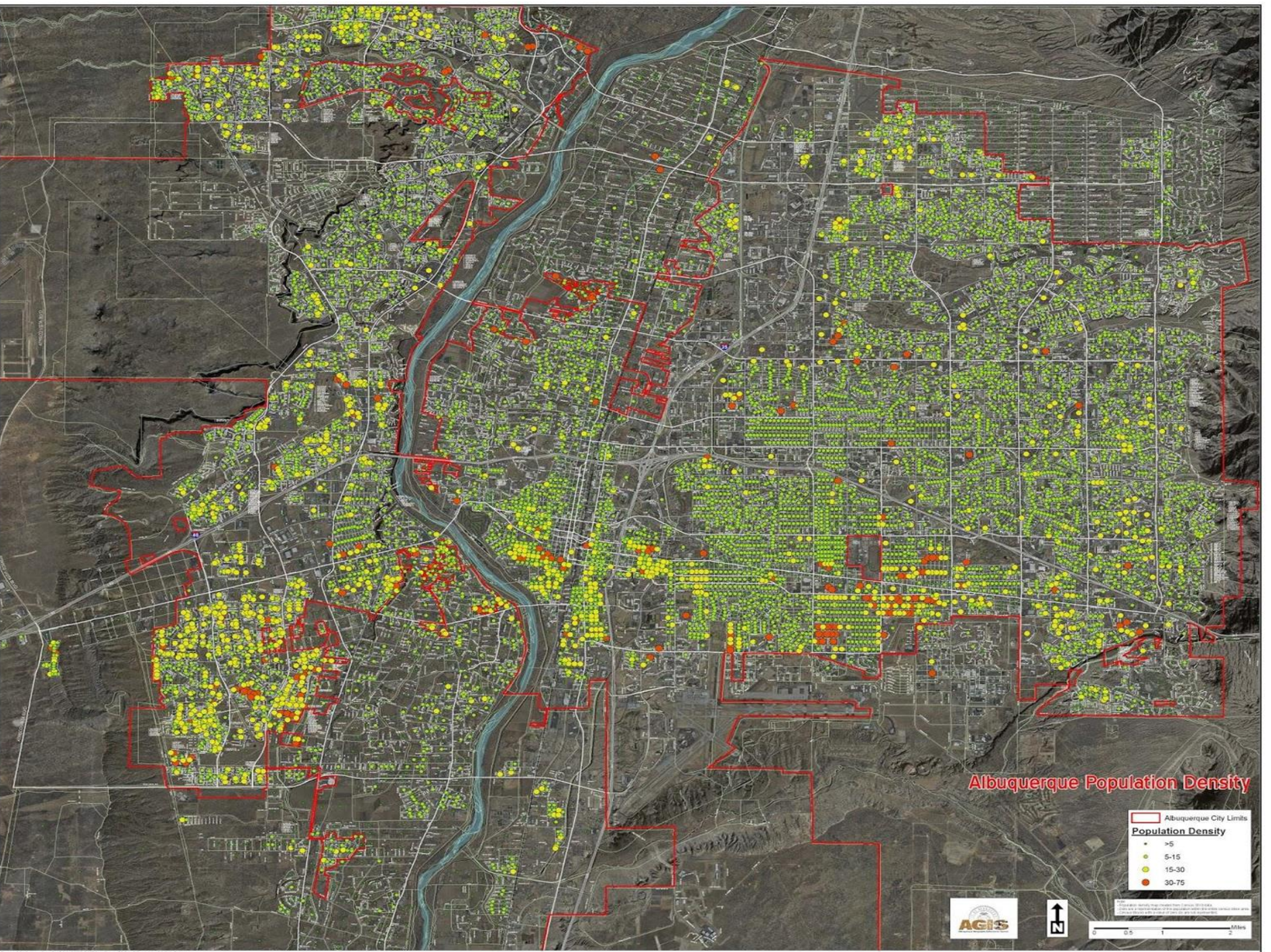
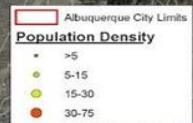


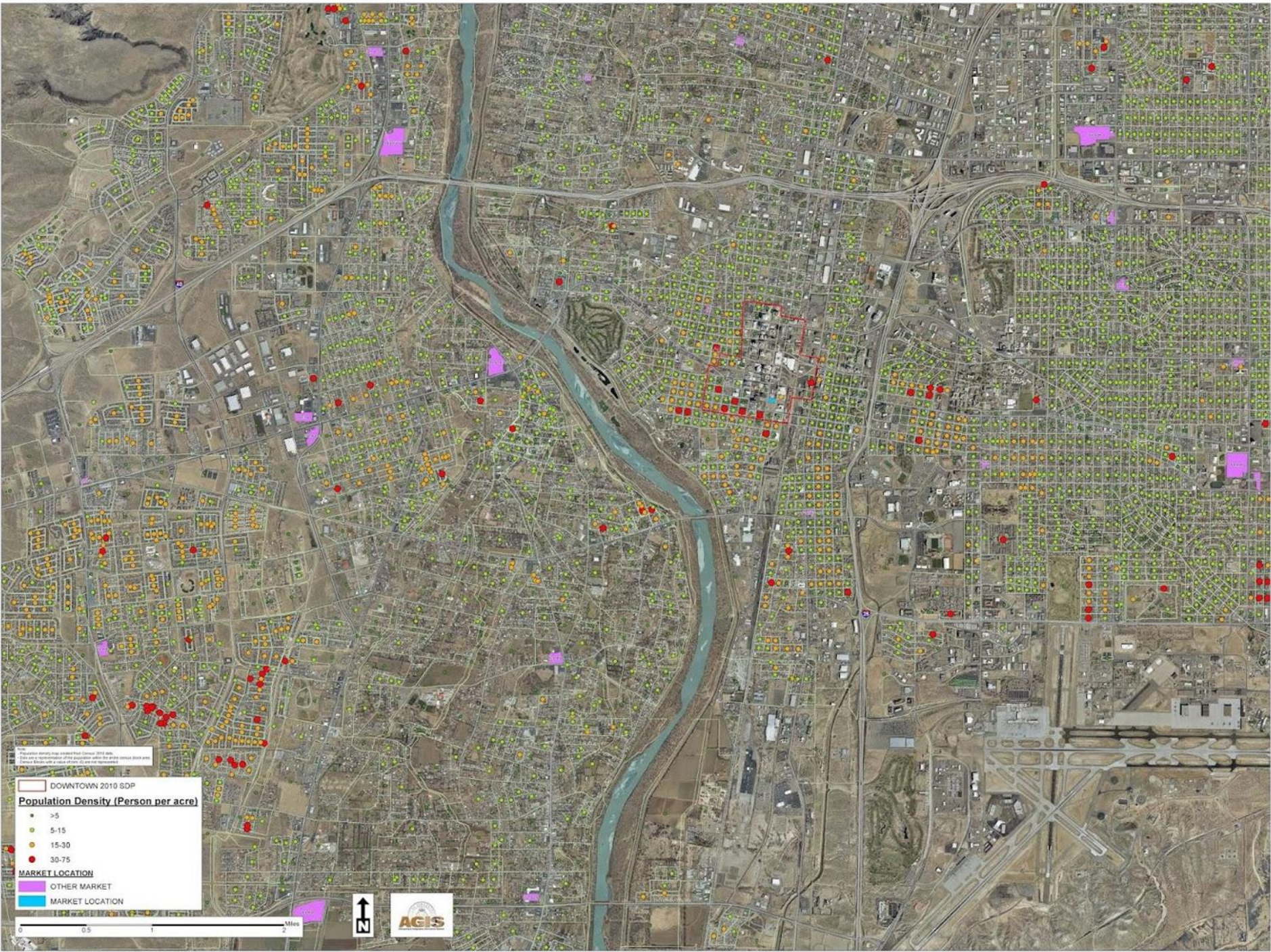

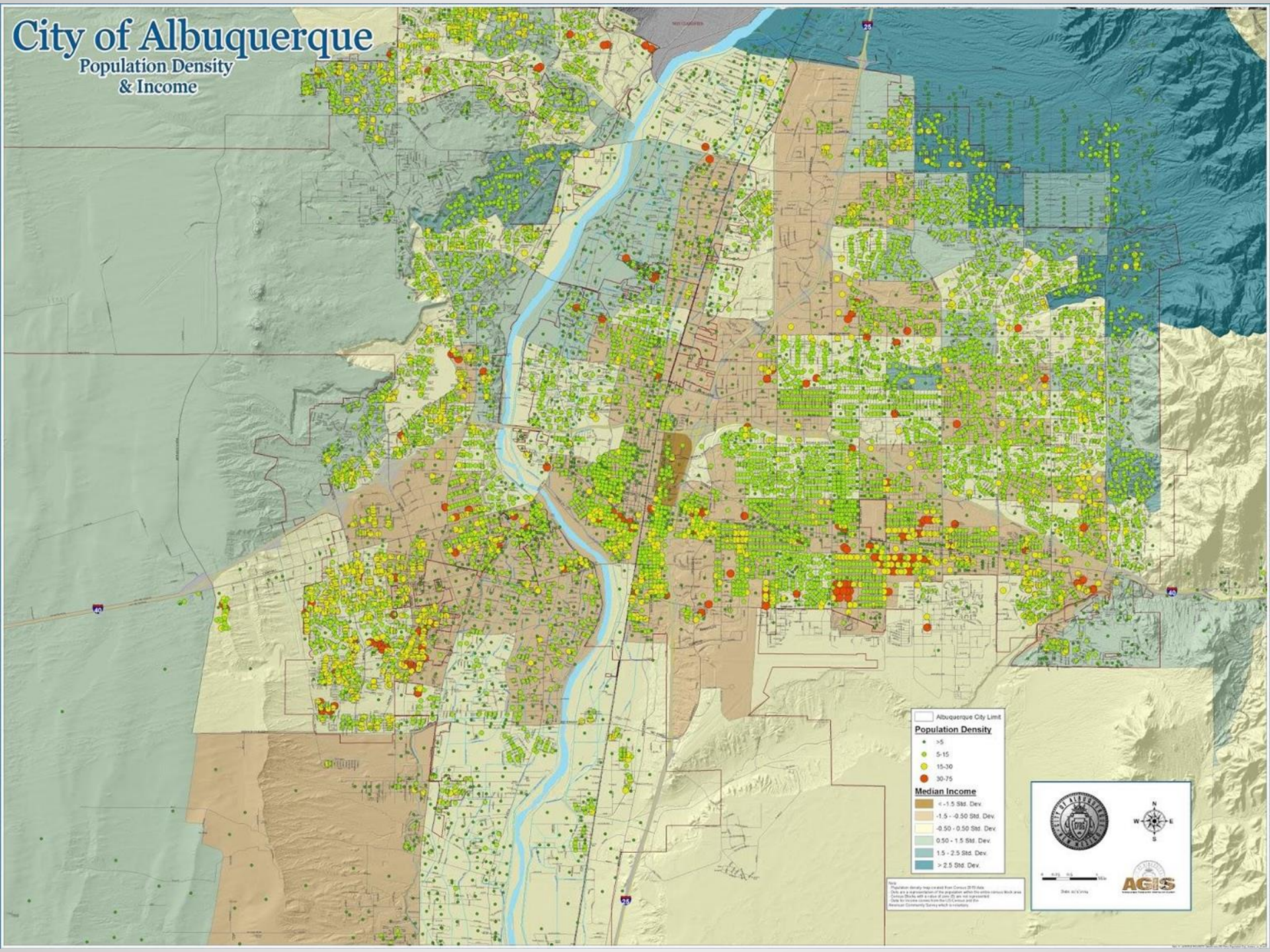

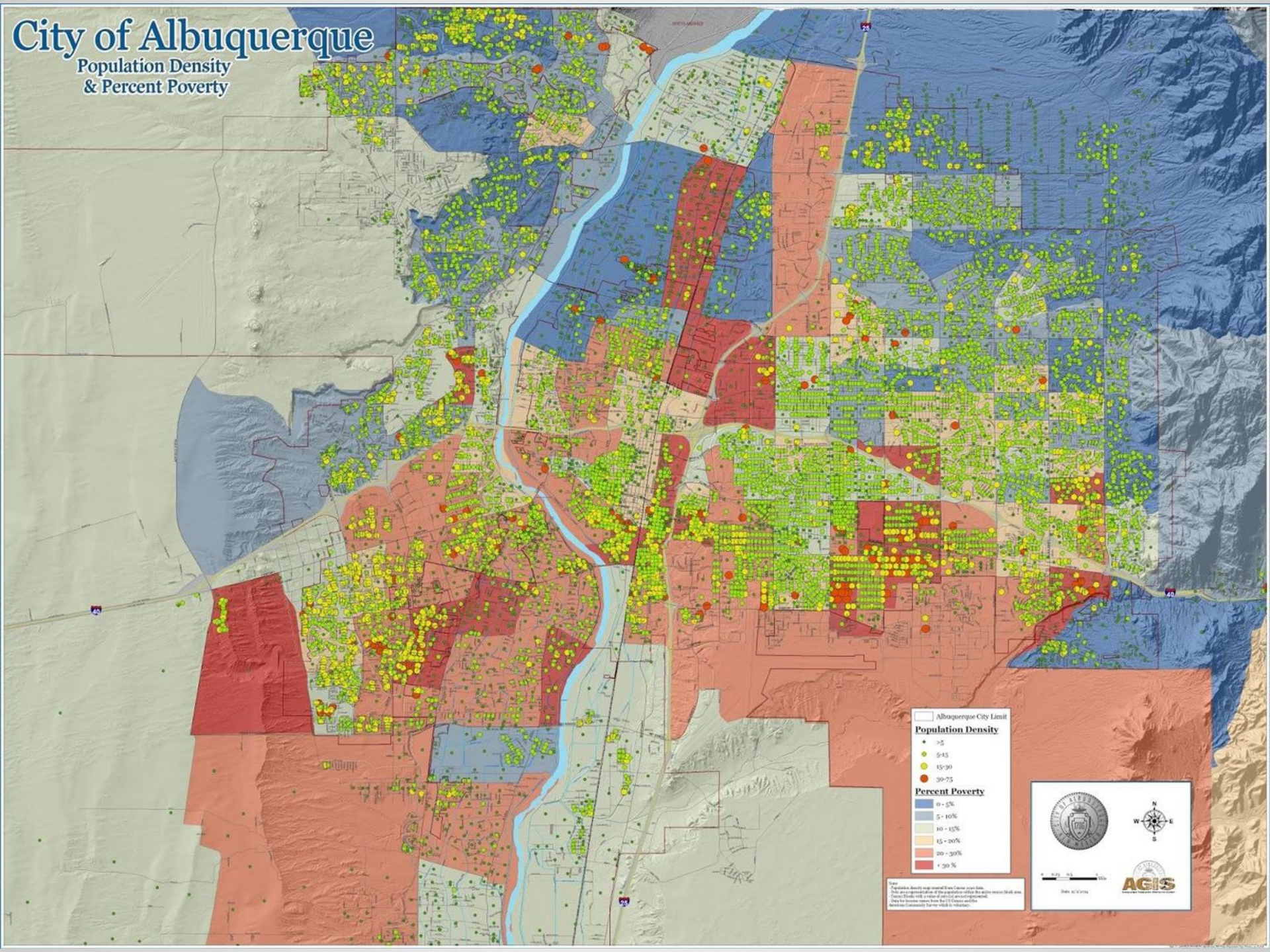
